Job Summary

Reporting to the Transition House Coordinator, the main duties are:

- To provide crisis intervention and support to women who have left violent or abusive relationships.
- To provide crisis intervention, information and support to crisis line callers.
- To enforce Transition House rules.

Education, Training and Experience

- Crisis Line training
- Human Services Diploma or equivalent post secondary education
- Experience in crisis intervention and/or adult support work
- Experience supporting women in dealing with domestic violence and/or supporting people dealing with substance abuse issues and current first aid certificate a strong asset

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities

- Knowledge of the dynamics of domestic violence and abuse
- Excellent verbal communication skills
- Good written communication skills
- Ability to provide non-judgmental, client centered support to people in crisis
- Ability to actively participate in a work-based team in a manner that is fully engaged, respectful, supportive and assertive
